We have lots in store for the preschoolers this month. First, we start off with Safari/Jungle Week and the kids will each be choosing a jungle animal to



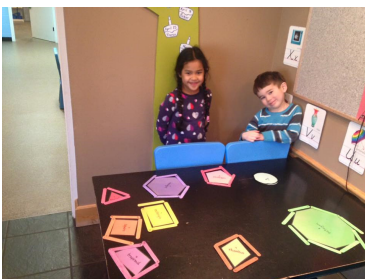
make life size out of construction paper. The sportcourt will be transformed into a jungle! We will also celebrate Dr. Seuss' birthday on Wednesday
